17 to the union of Mary L. Grant and Eugene Grant; he grew up in  
18 Bessemer, Alabama, where he studied music under various church  
19 musicians; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Grant earned an Associate of Arts  
21 Degree in Culinary Arts from Los Angeles Technical College, a  
22 Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration and a  
23 Bachelor of Arts Degree in Music Performance Vocalist from  
24 Miles College in Birmingham, Alabama, and an Honorary  
25 Doctorate Christian Business Humanities Degree from Global  
26 Evangelical Christian College and Seminary; and

1           WHEREAS, Mr. Grant served Mount Hebron Church in  
2 Bessemer and Mount Mariah Baptist Church in Los Angeles with  
3 his incredible musical gifts; he served as Director of  
4 Cultural and Fine Arts of Hopewell Baptist Church (Hillman  
5 Station); and

6           WHEREAS, he founded ALChris Media Entertainment  
7 Production record label, which produced the "Alabama People's  
8 Choice Mass Choir" project, "Getting My House In Order," and  
9 Alabama People's Choice Projects Foundations, Inc.; and

10          WHEREAS, he was the affectionate father of two sons;

12          WHEREAS, Mr. Grant chaired Alabama Symphony  
13 Orchestra outreach programs to underserved communities and  
14 made other significant contributions to the community while  
15 serving in numerous leadership capacities; and

16          WHEREAS, Mr. Grant was a valued member of the  
17 community; although his presence is greatly missed, his memory  
18 is cherished in the hearts and minds of all those who were  
19 fortunate enough to know him; now therefore,
