34 period of time to exceed nine (9) months in any single fiscal year.  
35 Provided, however, that no employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who  
36 is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed seventy five

1 percent (75%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as  
 2 authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor  
 3 shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed fourteen  
 4 hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal year.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
 6 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

7

8 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
 10 PROVISION. If the State Forestry Commission determines that temporary  
 11 firefighters, dispatchers, or pilots are required to meet the demands of a  
 12 wildfire season, and upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
 13 appropriations may be transferred from either Extra Help or Professional Fees  
 14 and Services to the proper character code for the employment of such  
 15 personnel.

16 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the deployment of air  
 17 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and  
 18 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
 19 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be  
 20 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in Section 3 and 30.

21 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for  
 22 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is  
 23 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees  
 24 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the  
 25 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation  
 26 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in Section 3  
 27 and 30.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
 29 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

31 SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO  
 33 EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to charge fees  
 34 to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission for  
 35 expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees shall be  
 36 deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a refund to



1 expenditure.

2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
 3 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

5 SECTION 45. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

7 ALLOCATION RESTRICTIONS. The Secretary of the Arkansas Department of  
 8 Agriculture shall at no time designate general revenue allocations to the  
 9 State Plant Board, the Arkansas Livestock and Poultry Commission and the  
 10 Arkansas Forestry Commission at a level less than the revenue distribution  
 11 provided in the Official Forecast of state general revenue in effect for each  
 12 of those agencies.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~  
 14 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

15

16 SECTION 46. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING

18 REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Forestry Commission shall present the following  
 19 data each month to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas  
 20 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. This report shall be due by  
 21 the 10th day of the month following the reporting period. The first reporting  
 22 period shall be July 2012.

23 a) All fund transfers completed by the Arkansas Forestry Commission from  
 24 any funding source including federal funds, and shall include a justification  
 25 for the completion of the fund transfers.

26 b) All expenditures incurred by the Arkansas Forestry Commission from  
 27 any funding source including federal funds, and shall include a justification  
 28 for the expenditure of the funds.

29 c) All revenue receipts of the Arkansas Forestry Commission including  
 30 but not limited to federal funds, general revenue, severance tax, acreage  
 31 tax, timber sales and seedlings sales.

32 d) All Arkansas Forestry Commission activities including but not limited  
 33 to, firefighting activities, fire prevention, and emergency response as it  
 34 relates to the Commission's statutory mission provided in Arkansas Code 15-  
 35 31-101.

36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2014~~

1 2015 through June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016.

2  
3 SECTION 47. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
4 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
6 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.  
12

13 SECTION 48. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
21

22 SECTION 49. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
23 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
24 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of  
26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm  
29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
