5 "Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
6 substitute:

7 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-12-105, **amend**
8 (2) introductory portion, and (2)(f); and **add** (2)(g) and (3) as follows:

9 **18-12-105. Unlawfully carrying a concealed weapon - unlawful**
10 **possession of weapons.** (2) It ~~shall not be~~ IS NOT an offense if the
11 defendant was:

12 (f) A United States probation officer or a United States pretrial
13 services officer while on duty and serving in the state of Colorado under
14 the authority of rules and regulations promulgated by the judicial
15 conference of the United States; OR

16 (g) LAWFULLY CARRYING A CONCEALED HANDGUN PURSUANT TO
17 THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN SUBSECTION (3) OF THIS SECTION.

18 (3) (a) A PERSON WHO IS AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND
19 IS PERMITTED TO POSSESS A HANDGUN PURSUANT TO FEDERAL AND STATE
20 LAW HAS THE SAME AUTHORITY TO CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN, AND
21 IS SUBJECT TO THE SAME LIMITATIONS, AS A PERSON WHO HOLDS A PERMIT
22 TO CARRY A CONCEALED HANDGUN, AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 18-12-214.

23 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
24 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
25 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
26 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
27 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
28 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
29 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
30 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
31 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."."

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
