

The Senate Judiciary Non-Civil Committee offered the following substitute to HB 60:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 16-11-130 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 exemptions from Code Sections 16-11-126 through 16-11-127.2, so as to provide an  
3 exemption from certain laws regarding the carrying and possession of firearms by certain  
4 judges; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

**SECTION 1.**

6 Code Section 16-11-130 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to exemptions  
7 from Code Sections 16-11-126 through 16-11-127.2, is amended in subsection (a) by revising  
8 paragraph (12) and by adding two new paragraphs to read as follows:

10 "(12) State and federal trial and appellate judges, judges of probate, juvenile, and  
11 magistrate courts, full-time judges of municipal and city courts, and permanent part-time  
12 judges of municipal and city courts, and former state trial and appellate judges retired  
13 from their respective offices under state retirement;

14 (12.1) Former state and federal judges, judges of probate, juvenile, and magistrate courts,  
15 full-time judges of municipal and city courts, and permanent part-time judges of  
16 municipal courts who are retired from their respective offices, provided that such judge  
17 would otherwise be qualified to be issued a weapons carry license;

18 (12.2) Former state and federal judges, judges of probate, juvenile, and magistrate courts,  
19 full-time judges of municipal and city courts, and permanent part-time judges of  
20 municipal courts who are no longer serving in their respective office, provided that he or  
21 she served as such judge for more than 24 months and provided, further, that such judge  
22 would otherwise be qualified to be issued a weapons carry license;"

**SECTION 2.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
