2 RELATING TO THE ECONOMIC ADVISORY COUNCIL; AMENDING SECTION 67-4704, IDAHO
3 CODE, TO REVISE COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE ECONOMIC ADVISORY COUN-
4 CIL AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-4704, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-4704. ECONOMIC ADVISORY COUNCIL -- APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS -- QUAL-
9 IFICATIONS. There shall be an economic advisory council to advise the de-
10 partment in the preparation and execution of plans, projects and programs in
11 the furtherance of the power and duties conferred by section 67-4703, Idaho
12 Code. The director shall consult, confer and advise with the advisory coun-
13 cil in connection with all decisions concerning the administration and de-
14 velopment of such plans, projects and programs. The approval of the advi-
15 sory council shall be a condition precedent to the undertaking of action in
16 the implementation of such plans, projects and programs by the department.
17 The advisory council shall consist of ~~seven~~ eight (78) persons, who shall be
18 appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the governor, and who shall serve
19 for three (3) year terms. They shall serve and shall be compensated as pro-
20 vided by section 59-509 (~~h~~), Idaho Code. One (1) person shall be appointed
21 to represent each of the ~~six~~ seven (67) planning regions of the state and one
22 (1) member shall serve in a statewide capacity. No more than ~~four~~ five (45)
23 members of the economic advisory council shall be from any one (1) political
24 party.
