DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-47-4-2.

Synopsis: Use of firearms to secure loans. Repeals the statute prohibiting the use of a firearm as a security.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to repeal a provision of the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-47-4-2 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
2 2017]. ~~Sec. 2: A person who makes a loan secured by a:~~
3 (1) mortgage;
4 (2) deposit; or
5 (3) pledge;
6 of a handgun commits a Class B misdemeanor.
