2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" and before "and to" change "R.S. 40:1379.3.3(B), (D)(1)
3 and (6), and (F)(2)" to "R.S. 40:1379.3(C)(8) and 1379.3.3(B), (D)(1) and (6), and (F)(2)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, at the beginning of line 3, change "40:1379.3.3(D)(9)" to "40:1379.3(I)(6) and
6 1379.3.3(D)(9)"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 3, after "firearms;" and before "to provide" insert "to provide relative to the
9 revocation or suspension of concealed handgun permits;"

11 On page 1, line 6, after "Section 1." and before "are" change "R.S. 40:1379.3.3(B), (D)(1)

18 "§1379.3. Statewide permits for concealed handguns; application procedures;

21 C. To qualify for a concealed handgun permit, a Louisiana resident shall:

23 (8) Not chronically and habitually use alcoholic beverages to the extent that
24 his normal faculties are impaired. It shall be presumed that an applicant or permittee
25 chronically and habitually uses alcoholic beverages to the extent that his normal
26 faculties are impaired if the applicant ~~has been found guilty of, or entered a plea of~~
27 ~~guilty or nolo contendere to operating a vehicle while intoxicated, or has been~~
28 admitted, either voluntarily or involuntarily, for treatment as an alcoholic, within the
29 five-year period immediately preceding the date on which the application is
30 submitted, or at any time after the application has been submitted.
