OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to public safety; modifying the process of firearm purchase by peace  
1.3 officers; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 624.  
1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[624.7135] FIREARM PURCHASE BY PEACE OFFICERS.**

1.6 An actively licensed Minnesota peace officer may purchase a firearm under this chapter  
1.7 by presenting the peace officer's badge or other officially issued government identification  
1.8 demonstrating that the person is currently employed as a peace officer in Minnesota, along  
1.9 with photo identification sufficient to prove the officer's identity. This proof shall be  
1.10 considered as the equivalent of presenting a transferee permit for the purchase of the firearm.
