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## AN ACT

To amend chapter 319, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a study on gun violence.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 319, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 319.520, to read as follows:

3 **319.520. 1. The department of public safety shall commission a study on gun**  
4 **violence in the state. The study shall include an examination of evidence and research that**  
5 **could be used to develop laws aimed at decreasing deaths and injuries from firearms.**

6 **2. The director of the department of public safety shall appoint an oversight review**  
7 **committee to oversee and review the results of such study.**

8 **3. On or before January 1, 2020, the oversight review committee shall submit a**  
9 **report of its findings to the general assembly. The department may collaborate with the**  
10 **department of health and senior services or any other public or private entity in**  
11 **conducting the study required under this section.**

12 **4. The department of public safety may promulgate all necessary rules and**  
13 **regulations for the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that**  
14 **term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this**  
15 **section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions**  
16 **of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are**  
**nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to**  
**chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are**

17 **subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule**
