Senator Craven

1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 16-20, by rewriting the lines to read:
2
3 "order upon the ex parte application of the plaintiff for a fixed period of time not to extend beyond
4 the date of the renewal hearing or 30 days from the date the current order is set to expire,
5 whichever occurs first, absent the express written consent of both parties or their attorneys. This
6 temporary renewal may not extend a temporary award of custody entered as part of a protective
7 order beyond the maximum one-year period. If a temporary renewal is granted, and the defendant
8 is not personally present in court, the order shall be served on the defendant in the same manner
9 as an ex parte order issued pursuant to G.S. 50B-2. If a temporary renewal is granted, the Clerk
10 shall provide a copy to the sheriff. The commission of an act as defined in G.S. 50B-1(a)".
