23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
last amended by Section 2, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
2014, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or

1 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
2 subject as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
9 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
10 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
11 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
12 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
13 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
14 issued on a staggered system.

15 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
16 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
17 applications for special license plates authorized under this
18 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
19 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
20 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
21 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
22 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
23 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
24 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
12 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
13 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
14 until the Commission receives one hundred ~~(100)~~ prepaid applications
15 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
16 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
17 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
18 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
19 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
20 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

21 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
22 follows:

1 1. Round and Square Dance License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 round and square dancing;

4 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
5 License Plates - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
6 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
7 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

8 3. National Rifle Association License Plates - such plates
9 shall be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the
10 Tax Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
12 Association;

13 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
15 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
16 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
17 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
18 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
19 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
20 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
22 contain the Masonic emblem;

23 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
24 Plates - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for

1 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
2 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
3 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
5 contain the Shriner's emblem;

6 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
7 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
8 ballooning in this state;

9 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
11 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
12 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
13 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
14 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
15 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
16 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
17 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
18 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

19 8. Knights of Columbus License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
21 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
22 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
23 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
24 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights

1 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
2 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
3 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
4 Columbus emblem;

5 9. Jaycees License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
6 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
7 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

9 10. Ducks Unlimited License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to members of Ducks Unlimited. Persons applying
11 for and renewing such license plates must show proof of tag
12 membership in Ducks Unlimited. The license plates shall be designed
13 in consultation with Ducks Unlimited;

14 11. Kiwanis International License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
16 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
17 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with Kiwanis International;

19 12. Certified Public Accountants License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
21 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
22 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
23 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
24 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed

1 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
2 Accountants;

3 13. Civil Emergency Management License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
5 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
6 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
7 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
8 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
9 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
10 emergency management department head;

11 14. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
13 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
14 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
15 Conservation Corps;

16 15. Rotarian License Plates - such plates shall be designed and
17 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
18 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
19 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
20 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
21 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
22 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
24 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

1 16. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
3 by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and issued to any
4 resident of this state who is a member of the Benevolent Protective
5 Order of Elks;

6 17. Humane Society License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
9 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
10 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
11 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

12 18. Oklahoma Mustang Club - such plates shall be designed,
13 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission, by the
14 Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this state who
15 is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons may apply
16 for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon presentment of proof
17 of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club. The plates shall be
18 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
19 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates;

20 19. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plates - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
22 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
23 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
24 consultation with American Business Clubs;

1 20. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
3 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
4 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
5 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
6 Oklahoma;

7 21. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

11 22. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plates - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public
15 School System;

16 23. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
18 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
19 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

20 24. Parrothead Club License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
22 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
23 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
24 for personalized license plates;

1 25. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
3 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
4 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

5 26. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
7 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
8 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
9 Association;

10 27. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
12 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
14 Sorority;

15 28. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
16 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
17 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
18 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
19 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
21 Incorporated;

22 29. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
24 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license

1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
2 of Health;

3 30. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
5 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
6 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
7 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

8 31. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
9 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
10 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community
11 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be
12 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of
13 America Incorporated;

14 32. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma
16 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
17 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority
18 Incorporated;

19 33. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
20 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi
21 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
22 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

23 34. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha

1 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
2 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity
3 Incorporated;

4 35. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways
5 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
6 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System
7 of Highways. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
8 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
9 Officials;

10 36. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
12 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
13 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity
14 Incorporated;

15 37. Sigma Gamma Rho License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho
17 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
18 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.
19 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma
20 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,
21 2013;

22 38. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
24 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates

1 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
2 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

3 39. Frederick Douglass High School License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
6 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
7 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

8 40. United States Air Force Academy License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
10 demonstrate support for the United States Air Force Academy;

11 41. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

14 42. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
15 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
16 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
18 Weather Center Directors;

19 43. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
21 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in

23 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support

7 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

6 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
7 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
8 representatives of the Frederick School District; and

9 70. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued
10 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.
11 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current
12 employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are
13 a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher.

14 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
15 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by
16 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise
17 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:
18 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
20 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
21 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the
22 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
23 Section 1104 of this title.

24

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
2 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
3 2014, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
5 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
6 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
7 financial assistance as provided by this section.

8 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
9 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
10 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
11 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
12 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

13 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
14 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
15 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
16 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
17 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
18 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
19 issued on a staggered system.

20 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
21 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
22 applications for special license plates authorized under this
23 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
24 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount

1 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
2 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
3 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
4 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
5 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
6 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
7 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

8 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
9 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
10 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
11 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
12 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
13 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
14 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
15 removed from the vehicle.

16 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
17 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
18 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
19 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
20 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
21 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
22 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
23 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
24 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
2 follows:

3 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

8 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
9 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
10 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
12 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
13 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
14 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
15 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
17 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
18 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
19 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
20 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
21 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
22 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
23 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

1 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
3 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
4 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
5 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
6 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
10 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
11 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
13 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
14 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
15 of the fire department.

16 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
17 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
18 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
19 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
20 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
21 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
22 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
23 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
24 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle

1 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
2 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
3 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
4 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
7 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
8 Living Memorial;

9 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
13 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
14 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
15 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
16 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
17 plates.

18 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
19 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
20 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
23 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
24 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child

1 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
2 the prevention of child abuse.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

5 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
6 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
8 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
9 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
10 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
11 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
12 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
13 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
14 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
16 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
17 issued;

18 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
20 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
22 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

23 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother

1 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
3 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
4 Oklahoma;

5 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
7 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
8 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
9 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
10 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
11 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
14 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
15 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
17 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
19 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
20 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician
21 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
22 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of

1 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
2 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
3 Revolving Fund;

4 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
8 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
9 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
10 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
11 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
12 provide services to crime victims;

13 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
16 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
17 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
18 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
19 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
20 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

21 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
22 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
23 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued

1 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
2 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
3 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
4 Section 1104.4 of this title;

5 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
6 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
8 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
9 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
10 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
12 Section 1104.3 of this title;

13 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
15 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
16 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
17 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
20 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
21 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
24 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the

1 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
2 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
3 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
4 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
5 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
6 follows:

- 7 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
8 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 9 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
10 Education Revolving Fund,
- 11 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
12 Career Technology Fund, and
- 13 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
14 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
15 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
16 Oklahoma Statutes.

17 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
18 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
19 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
20 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
21 paragraph;

22 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
23 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
24 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the

1 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
2 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
3 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
4 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
5 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
6 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
10 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
11 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
12 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
13 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
14 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
15 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

16 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
19 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
20 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
21 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
22 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
23 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
24 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts

1 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
2 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
3 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

4 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
6 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
7 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
8 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
9 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
11 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
12 of this title;

13 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
15 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
16 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
17 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
18 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
19 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
20 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

21 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
23 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
24 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive

1 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
2 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
3 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
4 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
5 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
6 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
7 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
8 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
9 specifically for created families;

10 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
11 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
12 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
13 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
14 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
15 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
16 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
17 this title;

18 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
20 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
21 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
22 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
23 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
24 Section 1104.7 of this title;

1 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
3 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
5 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
7 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
8 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
9 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
10 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
11 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
12 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

13 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
16 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
17 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
18 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
19 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
20 Section 1104.8 of this title;

21 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
22 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
23 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
24 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person

1 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
2 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
3 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
4 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
5 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
6 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
7 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
8 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
9 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
10 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
16 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
17 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
18 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
19 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
20 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
21 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
22 plate issued;

23 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The

1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
2 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
3 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

4 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
5 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
6 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
7 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
8 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
9 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
10 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
11 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

12 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
15 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
17 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
18 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
19 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
20 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
21 Section 1104.10 of this title;

22 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
24 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who

1 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
2 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
3 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
4 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
5 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
6 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

7 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
8 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
9 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
10 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
11 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
12 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
13 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
14 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
15 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
16 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

17 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
18 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
19 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
20 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
21 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
22 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
23 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
24 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America

1 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
2 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
3 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
4 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
5 plate issued;

6 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
8 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
10 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
11 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
12 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

13 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
15 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
16 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
17 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
18 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
19 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
20 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
21 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

22 37. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
23 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
24 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with

1 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,

5 38. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
6 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
7 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
8 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
10 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
11 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
12 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 1104.14 of this title;

13 39. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
16 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
17 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
18 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
19 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
20 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
21 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
22 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
23 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
24

1 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
2 each license plate issued;

3 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
5 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
6 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
7 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
8 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
9 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
10 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
11 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
12 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. The plate shall
13 be designed in consultation with Folds of Honor Incorporated and
14 shall contain the official Folds of Honor Incorporated logo which
15 includes the mark "Folds of Honor" across the bottom of the plate.
16 The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing
17 agreement with Folds of Honor Incorporated for any licensing fees
18 which may be required in order to use the Folds of Honor
19 Incorporated logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
20 for a payment to Folds of Honor Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars
21 (\$25.00) for each license plate issued;

22 41. Downed Bikers Association License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
24 for the Downed Bikers Association, a nonprofit charitable

1 organization exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the
2 Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), which provides
3 emotional and financial support for downed bikers. The license
4 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Central Oklahoma
5 Chapter of the Downed Bikers Association and shall contain any
6 official logo or design of the organization. The Tax Commission, if
7 necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with the Downed
8 Bikers Association for any licensing fees which may be required in
9 order to use the organization's logo or design. The licensing
10 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Downed Bikers
11 Association of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each
12 license plate;

13 42. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
15 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
16 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
17 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
18 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
19 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this
20 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
21 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
22 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 43. Buffalo Soldier License Plate - such plates shall be issued
24 to any person wishing to honor and celebrate the history and

1 contribution of the Buffalo Soldiers. The license plates shall be
2 designed in consultation with the Lawton-Fort Sill Chapter of the
3 Buffalo Soldiers 9th and 10th (Horse) Cavalry Association. As
4 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
5 deposited in the Buffalo Soldier License Plate Revolving Fund
6 created in Section 1104.16 of this title;

7 44. Prevent Blindness Oklahoma License Plate - such plates
8 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
9 for vision screening of school age children in this state. The
10 license plates shall be designed in consultation with Prevent
11 Blindness Oklahoma. As provided in this section, an amount of the
12 fee collected shall be deposited in the Prevent Blindness Oklahoma
13 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.17 of this
14 title;

15 45. Oklahoma State Capitol Restoration License Plate - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
17 demonstrate support for restoration of the Oklahoma State Capitol
18 building. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
19 the Friends of the Capitol corporation, created pursuant to Section
20 15.4 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes and the State Capitol
21 Preservation Commission created pursuant to Section 4102 of Title 74
22 of the Oklahoma Statutes. As provided in this section, an amount of
23 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Friends of the
24

1 Capitol License Plate Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.18
2 of this title;

3 46. Eastern Red Cedar Tree License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
5 Commission and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
6 for the removal of Eastern Red Cedar trees from lands in the state
7 and to develop marketable uses for the harvested trees. The license
8 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Eastern Red Cedar
9 Registry Board. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited in the Eastern Red Cedar Revolving Fund created
11 in Section 18-407 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The money
12 shall be designated for and may only be expended for the purposes as
13 set forth in the Eastern Red Cedar Registry Board Act;

14 47. Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate - such plates
15 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
16 for the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer
17 Research Fund. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
18 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six.
19 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
20 University of Oklahoma Foundation, Pancreatic Cancer Research Fund.
21 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
22 deposited in the Pancreatic Cancer Research License Plate Revolving
23 Fund created in Section 1104.19 of this title;

24

1 48. Alzheimer's Research License Plate - such plates shall be
2 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
3 Oklahoma Chapter of the Alzheimer's Association. The license plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
5 Alzheimer's Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
6 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Alzheimer's Research
7 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.20 of this
8 title;

9 49. Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate - such plates
10 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
11 for the Oklahoma Hospice and Palliative Care Association. The
12 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
13 Hospice and Palliative Care Association. As provided in this
14 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
15 Hospice and Palliative Care License Plate Revolving Fund created in
16 Section 1104.21 of this title;

17 50. Juvenile Diabetes Research License Plate - such plates
18 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
19 for the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
20 Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
21 with the Oklahoma Chapters of the Juvenile Diabetes Research
22 Foundation. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
23 collected shall be deposited in the Juvenile Diabetes Research
24

1 License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.22 of this
2 title;

3 51. Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate - such plates
4 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
5 for the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Deer Creek Schools Foundation. As
7 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
8 deposited in the Deer Creek Schools Foundation License Plate
9 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.23 of this title;

10 52. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate - such plates
11 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
12 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
13 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As
14 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
15 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created
16 in Section 1104.24 of this title;

17 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
18 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
19 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police. The license plates shall
20 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
21 of Police. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
22 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
23 of Police License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section ~~1~~ 1104.25
24 of this ~~act~~ title;

1 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.
4 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
5 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission
6 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with
7 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be
8 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian
10 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued; ~~and~~

12 55. Oklahoma Nurses License Plate - such plates shall be issued
13 to any person licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act
14 and providing such documentation of current licensure as may be
15 required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The license plates shall
16 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Nurses Association.
17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
18 deposited in the Oklahoma Nurses License Plate Revolving Fund
19 created in Section 4 1104.26 of this ~~act~~ title;

20 56. Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame License Plate - such plates
21 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
22 Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame. The license plates shall be designed
23 in consultation with the administration of the Oklahoma Sports Hall
24 of Fame. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter

1 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame for
2 any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Hall of
3 Fame's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a
4 payment to the Oklahoma Sports Hall of Fame of not more than Twenty
5 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

6 57. Childhood Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates
7 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
8 Oklahoma Childrens' Cancer Association. The license plates shall be
9 designed in consultation with the administration of the Oklahoma
10 Childrens' Cancer Association. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be
11 authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma
12 Childrens' Cancer Association for any licensing fees which may be
13 required in order to use the Oklahoma Childrens' Cancer
14 Association's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
15 for a payment to the Oklahoma Childrens' Cancer Association of not
16 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued.

17 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
18 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
19 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
20 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

21 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
22 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
23 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
24 license plate;

1 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
3 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
4 and

5 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
6 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
