AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, substitute the following for the title,
enacting clause and the entire body of the bill:

"[motor vehicles - special license plates -
effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.2, as
last amended by Section 12 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 831 of the
1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
follows:

Section 1135.2. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as
provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
5 registered for the current year.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
12 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and
13 amateur radio operator license plates.

14 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
15 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
16 applications for special license plates authorized under this
17 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
18 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
19 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
20 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
21 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
22 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
23 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
24

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
4 follows:

5 1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
7 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war
8 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification
9 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war
10 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having
11 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving
12 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not
13 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
14 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war
15 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
16 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
17 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
18 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
19 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

20 2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National
22 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
23 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
24 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

1 3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National
3 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide
4 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be
5 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

6 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed
7 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States
8 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry
9 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
10 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member
11 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably
12 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying
13 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military
14 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or
15 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or
16 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof
17 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required
18 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

19 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been
21 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply
22 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each
23 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
24 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

1 6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are
3 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse
4 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
5 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the
6 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon
7 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action
8 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse
9 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each
10 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in
11 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
12 of one (1) ton or less;

13 7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper
15 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
16 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such
17 resident has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration.
18 Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient license plate
19 for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
20 less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who has been
21 awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such spouse has not
22 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has been terminated
23 by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such plate for one
24 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The

1 license plate created by this paragraph shall be exempt from the fee
2 provided by this section for special license plates;

3 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
5 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
6 the United States as being:

7 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December
8 7, 1941,

9 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of
10 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,
11 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to
12 exceed three (3) miles, and

13 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
14 States Armed Forces.

15 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate
16 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
17 less;

18 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
19 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States
20 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United
21 States as being:

22 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces in February
23 of 1945,

24

1 b. stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate
2 vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and

3 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
4 States Armed Forces.

5 Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each
6 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

7 Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall
8 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and
9 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the
10 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."
11 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such
12 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other
13 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the
14 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of
15 registration after the initial issue;

16 10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the
18 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
19 the United States as being:

20 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,
21 1944,

22 b. a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of
23 Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such
24 participation cannot be verified by the United States

1 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of
2 the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its
3 discretion, accept evidence of such participation from
4 the person applying for the license plate, and

5 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United
6 States Armed Forces.

7 Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for
8 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

9 11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were
11 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse
12 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by
13 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action
14 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person
15 was killed in action and that the person making the application is
16 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse
17 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two
18 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)
19 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
20 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
21 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
22 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

23 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were

1 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply
2 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification
3 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making
4 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent
5 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two
6 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one
7 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special
8 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to
9 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration
10 fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

11 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the
13 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the
14 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or
15 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a
16 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated
17 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

18 14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United
20 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such
21 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

23 15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for any currently employed, reserve or retired municipal

1 police officer or full-time, reserve or retired university police
2 officer certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
3 Training or common education police officer certified by the Council
4 on Law Enforcement Education and Training. Police officers may
5 apply for police officer license plates for vehicles with a rated
6 capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon proof of
7 employment by or retirement from a municipal, university or common
8 education police department by either an identification card or
9 letter from the chief of the police department or the Oklahoma
10 Police Pension and Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for
11 such plates shall provide proof of eligibility upon initial
12 application, but shall not be required to provide proof of
13 eligibility annually. The license plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with municipal police departments of this state;
15 provided, the license plate for motorcycles may be of similar design
16 to the license plate for motor vehicles or may be a new design in
17 order to meet space requirements for a motorcycle license plate;

18 16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
20 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
21 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
22 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
23 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from
24 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may

1 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a
2 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

3 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall
4 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
5 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold
6 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, U.S. Army Air Corps,
7 Marines or Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which
8 the member belonged. For the purpose of license plate
9 identification, the plate shall contain four digits, two digits at
10 the left and two digits at the right of the insignia or emblem.
11 Centered on the bottom of the license plate shall be the words
12 "WORLD WAR II";

13 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United
15 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be
16 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of
17 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having
18 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from June
19 27, 1950, to January 31, 1955, both dates inclusive. The former
20 members may apply for a Korean War Veteran license plate for
21 vehicles with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

22 The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall
23 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia
24 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold

1 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or
2 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member
3 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the
4 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two
5 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the
6 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

7 18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and
9 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or
10 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only
11 be produced upon application;

12 19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are
14 residents of this state. Such persons must present an
15 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a
16 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with
17 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend
18 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the
19 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and
20 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the
21 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red
22 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design
23 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
24

1 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
2 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

3 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall
4 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any
5 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars
6 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of
7 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans
8 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed
9 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

10 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed
11 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the
12 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and
13 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert
14 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity
15 of one (1) ton or less;

16 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of
18 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may
19 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle
20 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

21 23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates
22 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor
23 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in
24 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

1 24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air
3 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate
4 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
5 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license
6 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

7 25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed
8 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for
9 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-
10 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
11 the Ninety-Nines;

12 26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall
13 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.
14 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend
15 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the
16 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".
17 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate
18 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or
19 less;

20 27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall
21 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
22 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United
23 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat
24

1 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
2 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

3 28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of
5 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for
6 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall
7 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

8 29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
10 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the
11 United States Secretary of Defense;

12 30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
14 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any
15 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as
16 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such
17 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

19 31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed
20 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate
21 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the
22 district number;

23 32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United

1 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the
2 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected
3 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which
4 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been
5 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a
6 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the
7 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability
8 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons
9 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license
10 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no
11 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying
12 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any
13 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or
14 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or
15 annulment, or a surviving spouse in receipt of Dependency and
16 Indemnity Compensation from the United States Department of Veterans
17 Affairs, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one
18 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
19 fee provided by this section for the special license plate
20 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
21 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
22 levied by Section 1132 of this title. The total expense of this
23 license plate shall not exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00).

24

1 If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate
2 and is also eligible for a physically disabled placard under the
3 provisions of Section 15-112 of this title, the person shall be
4 eligible to receive a disabled veterans license plate that also
5 displays the international accessibility symbol, which is a stylized
6 human figure in a wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled
7 veteran with a disabled veterans license plate with the
8 international accessibility symbol, the plate shall be returned to
9 the Tax Commission;

10 33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such
11 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force
12 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show
13 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be
14 designed in consultation with the Association;

15 34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state
17 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons
18 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for
19 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.
20 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
21 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the
22 Academy;

23 35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall
24 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's

1 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal
2 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor
3 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been
4 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.
5 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle
6 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such
7 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Tax
8 Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have
9 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call
10 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications
11 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All
12 applications for such plates must be made to the Tax Commission on
13 or before the first day of October of any year for such plates for
14 the following calendar year and must be accompanied by the fee
15 required in this section together with a certificate, or such other
16 evidence as the Tax Commission may require, of proof that applicant
17 has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's license
18 and proof of applicant's ownership of a vehicle in which radio
19 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall
20 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any
21 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The
22 right to such special identification plates herein provided for
23 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the
24 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

1 36. American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for
3 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of
5 Oklahoma;

6 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or
8 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for
9 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or
10 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county
11 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the
12 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which
13 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.
14 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
15 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
16 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this
18 state;

19 38. Gold Star Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed to honor the surviving spouses and children of
21 qualified veterans. As used in this paragraph, "qualified veteran"
22 shall mean:

23 a. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
24 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the

1 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a direct result
2 of the performance of duties for any branch of the
3 United States Armed Forces or Oklahoma National Guard
4 while on active military duty, or

- 5 b. any person honorably discharged from any branch of the
6 United States Armed Forces or as a member of the
7 Oklahoma National Guard, who died as a result of
8 injury, illness or disease caused by the performance
9 of such duties while on active duty, whether the death
10 occurred while on active duty or after the honorable
11 discharge of such person.

12 The fee provided by this section for the special license plate
13 authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to all other
14 registration fees provided by law, except the registration fees
15 levied by Section 1132 of this title;

16 39. Korea Defense Service Medal License Plates - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who has
18 been awarded the Korea Defense Service Medal by the United States
19 Secretary of Defense. Such persons may apply for a Korea Defense
20 Service Medal license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
21 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

22 40. 180th Infantry License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed for members and prior members of the 180th Infantry.

24 Persons applying for such license plate must obtain and provide

1 proof of their membership from the 180th Infantry Association. The
2 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the 180th
3 Infantry;

4 41. Operation Iraqi Freedom Veteran License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
6 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
7 Operation Iraqi Freedom. Such person may apply for an Operation
8 Iraqi Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated
9 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 42. United States Air Force Academy Alumni License Plates -
11 such plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this
12 state who is an alumnus of the United States Air Force Academy.
13 Such persons may apply for a United States Air Force Academy Alumnus
14 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
15 (1) ton or less;

16 43. Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran License Plate - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
18 present member of the United States Armed Forces who served in
19 Operation Enduring Freedom on or after September 11, 2001. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
21 Department of the State of Oklahoma. Such person may apply for an
22 Operation Enduring Freedom Veteran license plate for each vehicle
23 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

24

1 44. Military Multi-Decoration License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member
3 of the United States Armed Forces who qualifies for more than one
4 military decoration license plate pursuant to the provisions of this
5 section. The Tax Commission shall develop and implement a system
6 whereby the designs of the eligible license plates can be included
7 together on a single license plate. Such person may apply for a
8 Military Multi-Decoration license plate for each vehicle with a
9 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

10 45. Global War on Terror Expeditionary License Plate - such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or
12 present member of the United States Armed Forces who has earned a
13 Global War on Terror Expeditionary decoration. The license plate
14 shall be designed in consultation with the United States Institute
15 of Heraldry and the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma.
16 Such person may apply for a Global War on Terror Expeditionary
17 license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one
18 (1) ton or less;

19 46. Legion of Merit Medal Recipient License Plates - such
20 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state presenting
21 proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans
22 Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that
23 such resident has been awarded the Legion of Merit military
24 decoration. Such persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient

1 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one
2 (1) ton or less. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma;

4 47. 1-179th License Plates - such plates shall be designed for
5 members, prior members and members of the household of a member or
6 former member of the 1-179th Infantry. Persons applying for such
7 license plate must obtain and provide proof of their membership
8 association with the 1-179th Infantry Association. The license
9 plate shall be designed in consultation with the 1-179th Infantry;

10 48. ~~2-179th~~ 1-279th License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed for members, prior members and members of the household of
12 a member or former member of the ~~2-179th~~ 1-279th Infantry. Persons
13 applying for such license plate must obtain and provide proof of
14 their membership association with the ~~2-179th~~ 1-279th Infantry
15 Association. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
16 with the ~~2-179th~~ 1-279th Infantry;

17 49. Combat Action Ribbon Recipient License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Action Ribbon
19 who present proper certification from the United States Department
20 of the Navy. The license plate shall include the Combat Action
21 Ribbon earned by the recipient. Such persons may apply for a Combat
22 Action Ribbon Recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated
23 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

24

1 50. Oklahoma Submarine Veterans License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed for any resident of this state who is a United
3 States submarine veteran and presents either a Department of Defense
4 form 214 or other documentation certifying such service. Such
5 persons may apply for an Oklahoma Submarine Veterans license plate
6 for vehicles having a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
7 license plate design shall include both gold and silver dolphins to
8 represent both officer and enlisted service members; and

9 51. United States Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps License
10 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any honorably
11 discharged or present member of the United States Navy Seabees or
12 Civil Engineer Corps. Such persons may apply for a United States
13 Navy Seabees and Civil Engineer Corps license plate for vehicles
14 having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The
15 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Military
16 Department of the State of Oklahoma.

17 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such
18 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to
19 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License
20 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
21 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration
22 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

23 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
24 last amended by Section 16 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 831 of the

1 1st Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 Section 1135.5. A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
4 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
5 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
6 financial assistance as provided by this section.

7 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
8 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
9 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
10 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
11 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

12 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
13 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
14 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
15 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
16 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
17 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
18 issued on a staggered system.

19 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
20 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
21 applications for special license plates authorized under this
22 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
23 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
24 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary

1 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
2 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
3 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
4 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
5 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
6 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

7 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
8 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
9 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
10 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
11 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
12 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
13 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
14 removed from the vehicle.

15 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
16 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
17 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
18 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
19 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
20 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
21 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
22 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
23 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

24

1 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
2 follows:

3 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
4 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
5 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
6 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

8 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
9 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
10 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
12 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
13 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
14 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
15 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
17 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
18 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
19 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
20 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
21 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
22 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
23 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

1 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
3 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
4 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
5 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
6 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
10 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
11 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
12 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
13 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
14 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
15 of the fire department.

16 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
17 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
18 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
19 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
20 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
21 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
22 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
23 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
24 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle

1 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
2 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
3 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
4 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

5 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
7 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
8 Living Memorial;

9 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
11 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
13 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
14 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
15 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
16 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
17 plates.

18 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
19 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
20 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
22 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
23 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
24 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child

1 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
2 the prevention of child abuse.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

5 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
6 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
8 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
9 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
10 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
11 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
12 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
13 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
14 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
16 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
17 issued;

18 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
20 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
22 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

23 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother

1 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
3 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
4 Oklahoma;

5 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
7 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
8 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
9 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
10 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
11 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

12 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
14 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
15 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
16 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
17 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
18 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
19 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
20 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician
21 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
22 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
24 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of

1 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
2 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
3 Revolving Fund;

4 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
5 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
7 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
8 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
9 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
10 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
11 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
12 provide services to crime victims;

13 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
16 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
17 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
18 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
19 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
20 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

21 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
22 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
23 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued

1 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
2 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
3 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
4 Section 1104.4 of this title;

5 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
6 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
8 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
9 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
10 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
12 Section 1104.3 of this title;

13 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
15 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
16 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
17 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
20 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
21 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

22 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
24 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the

1 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
2 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
3 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
4 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
5 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
6 follows:

- 7 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
8 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 9 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
10 Education Revolving Fund,
- 11 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
12 Career Technology Fund, and
- 13 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
14 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
15 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
16 Oklahoma Statutes.

17 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
18 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
19 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
20 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
21 paragraph;

22 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
23 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
24 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the

1 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
2 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
3 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
4 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
5 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
6 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
7 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
8 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
9 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
10 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
11 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
12 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
13 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
14 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
15 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

16 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
19 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
20 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
21 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
22 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
23 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
24 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts

1 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
2 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
3 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

4 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
5 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
6 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
7 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
8 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
9 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
11 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
12 of this title;

13 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
14 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
15 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
16 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
17 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
18 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
19 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
20 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

21 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
22 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
23 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
24 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive

1 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
2 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
3 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
4 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
5 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
6 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
7 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
8 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
9 specifically for created families;

10 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
11 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
12 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
13 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
14 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
15 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
16 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
17 this title;

18 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
20 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
21 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
22 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
23 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
24 Section 1104.7 of this title;

1 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
3 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
5 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
7 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
8 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
9 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
10 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
11 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
12 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

13 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
16 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
17 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
18 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
19 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
20 Section 1104.8 of this title;

21 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
22 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
23 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
24 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person

1 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
2 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
3 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
4 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
5 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
6 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
7 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
8 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
9 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
10 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
15 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
16 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
17 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
18 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
19 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
20 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
21 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
22 plate issued;

23 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The

1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
2 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
3 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

4 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
5 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
6 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
7 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
8 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
9 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty

8 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 3,
9 Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section
10 1135.5), which relates to special license plates;
11 reauthorizing the Lupus Awareness and Education
12 License Plate; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
15 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2014 (47 O.S. Supp.
16 2014, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
18 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
19 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
20 financial assistance as provided by this section.

21 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
22 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
23 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
24 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
7 issued on a staggered system.

8 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
9 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
10 applications for special license plates authorized under this
11 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
12 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
13 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
14 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
15 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
16 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
17 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
18 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
19 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

20 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
21 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
22 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
23 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
24 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license

1 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration

16 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
17 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
18 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of

20 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
21 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
22 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency

1 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
2 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
3 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
4 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
5 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
6 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
7 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Technician
8 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
9 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

10 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
12 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount

10 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
11 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission

4 52. Lupus Awareness and Education License Plate - such plates
5 shall be issued to any person wishing to provide financial support
6 for the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be
7 designed in consultation with the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma. As
8 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
9 deposited in the Oklahoma Lupus License Plate Revolving Fund created
10 in Section 1104.24 of this title;

11 53. Chiefs of Police License Plate - such plates shall be
12 issued to any person wishing to provide financial support for the
13 Oklahoma Association of Chiefs of Police. The license plates shall
14 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
15 of Police. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
16 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association of Chiefs
17 of Police License Plate Revolving Fund created in Section ~~+~~ 1104.25
18 of this ~~act~~ title;

19 54. Crossings Christian School License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support for Crossings Christian School located in Oklahoma City.
22 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the
23 administration of Crossings Christian School. The Tax Commission
24 shall be authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with

1 Crossings Christian School for any licensing fees which may be
2 required in order to use the school's logo or design. The licensing
3 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Crossings Christian
4 School of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
5 plate issued; and

6 55. Oklahoma Nurses License Plate - such plates shall be issued
7 to any person licensed pursuant to the Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act
8 and providing such documentation of current licensure as may be
9 required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission. The license plates shall
10 be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Nurses Association.
11 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
12 deposited in the Oklahoma Nurses License Plate Revolving Fund

14 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
15 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
16 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
17 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

18 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
19 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
20 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
21 license plate;

22 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the

3 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
4 provided in Section 1104 of this title.
