11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.31 of Title 21, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The following statewide or federally elected or appointed  
16 officials may carry a firearm on his or her person throughout the  
17 state of Oklahoma, while in the performance of official duties of  
18 the office, if the person has successfully completed a handgun  
19 qualification course pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self  
20 Defense Act:

- 21 1. The Governor;  
22 2. The Lieutenant Governor;  
23 3. The State Auditor and Inspector;  
24 4. The Secretary of State;

- 1        5. The Attorney General;
- 2        6. The State Treasurer;
- 3        7. The Superintendent of Public Instruction;
- 4        8. The Commissioner of Labor;
- 5        9. The Insurance Commissioner;
- 6        10. The Corporation Commissioners;
- 7        11. Members of the United States Senate from Oklahoma; and
- 8        12. Members of the United States House of Representatives from
- 9 Oklahoma.

10        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
