9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to firearms; providing for certain
11 statewide or federally elected or appointed officials
12 to carry a firearm; providing for carry while in
13 performance of duties; requiring certain
14 qualification course; providing exception for certain
15 property; providing for codification; and providing
16 an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.31 of Title 21, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 During their elected term of office, the following statewide or
21 federally elected officials may carry a firearm on his or her person
22 throughout the State of Oklahoma, while in the performance of
23 official duties of the office, if the person has successfully

1 completed a handgun qualification course pursuant to the provisions
2 of the Oklahoma Self Defense Act:

- 3 1. The Governor;
- 4 2. The Lieutenant Governor;
- 5 3. The State Auditor and Inspector;
- 6 4. The Secretary of State;
- 7 5. The Attorney General;
- 8 6. The State Treasurer;
- 9 7. The Superintendent of Public Instruction;
- 10 8. The Commissioner of Labor;
- 11 9. The Insurance Commissioner;
- 12 10. The Corporation Commissioners;
- 13 11. Members of the United States Senate serving the State of
14 Oklahoma; and
- 15 12. Members of the United States House of Representatives
16 serving the State of Oklahoma.

17 Provided, however, state or federal elected officials shall be
18 specifically prohibited from carrying a firearm on any public or
19 private elementary or secondary school property that does not have a
20 policy that authorizes the carrying of firearms on the school
21 property, any college, university or technology center school
22 property and any private property or property owned by a business
23 entity that specifically prohibits persons from carrying firearms on
24

1 the property as provided in Section 1290.22 of Title 21 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
