

House Bill 2413

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor John A. Kitzhaber, M.D., for Department of Human Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to report to Legislative Assembly changes necessary to achieve goal of reducing long term care facility bed capacity.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to long term care facilities; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall report to the Legislative Assembly,**
5 **in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, no later than September 1, 2015, any legislative**
6 **changes that are necessary to implement section 15, chapter 608, Oregon Laws 2013, and to**
7 **meet the goal expressed in section 15 (3), chapter 608, Oregon Laws 2013, to reduce the long**
8 **term care facility bed capacity in Oregon by 1,500 beds.**

9 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**
