**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 4002**

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall engage an im-**
3 **partial third-party organization to:**

4 **“(a) Conduct annual reviews of programs that are funded wholly**
5 **or in part by state funds to provide substance use disorder treatment**
6 **and recovery services; and**

7 **“(b) Measure the success of the programs in providing the services.**

8 **“(2) The third-party organization shall:**

9 **“(a) Review each program’s financial records and current budget;**

10 **“(b) Identify the sources of each program’s funding and percentages**
11 **of the funding that come from the state, counties, cities, private do-**
12 **nations, foundations and other sources;**

13 **“(c) Conduct an onsite visit of each program’s facilities to observe**
14 **the services that each program provides and how the services are**
15 **provided; and**

16 **“(d) Collect data from each program that is necessary to compile**
17 **the report described in subsection (3) of this section.**

18 **“(3) No later than June 30, the third-party organization shall an-**
19 **nually submit to the Legislative Assembly, in the manner provided in**
20 **ORS 192.245, a report detailing, for each program during the previous**
21 **12-month period:**

1 “(a) Whether the program tracks the number of individuals to
2 whom the program provided substance use disorder treatment and, if
3 so, how many individuals received services;

4 “(b) Whether the program tracks the success rate of the program
5 in providing substance use disorder treatment or recovery services and
6 if so, what was the success rate of the program;

7 “(c) Whether the services provided were cost-effective;

8 “(d) Whether the program focused on treatment for and recovery
9 from substance use disorders;

10 “(e) The program’s annual budget;

11 “(f) The program’s target population;

12 “(g) The number of individuals to whom the program attempted to
13 provide services;

14 “(h) The number of individuals for whom the program succeeded in
15 providing services;

16 “(i) The success rate of the program in helping individuals to
17 achieve and remain in recovery; and

18 “(j) The cost of the services provided by each program for each in-
19 dividual the program helped to achieve and remain in recovery.

20 “(4) The report described in subsection (3) of this section shall also
21 include the third-party organization’s standard for measuring the
22 success of a program in helping individuals to achieve and remain in
23 recovery.”.

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
