It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1           SECTION 1. Section 11-47-20 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled "Weapons"

2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3           **11-47-20. Sale or possession of silencers.**

4           It shall be unlawful within this state to manufacture, sell, purchase, or possess any muffler,

5 silencer, or device for deadening or muffling the sound of a firearm when discharged; provided,

6 however, that law enforcement officers utilizing said devices while acting within the scope of their

7 official duties, as tactical teams and under the direct supervision of the police chief or the colonel

8 of the state police or their designee, shall not be in violation of this section. Violations of this section

9 shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year and one day.

10           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
