AMENDMENT 1218A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1 An Act to prohibit certain political subdivisions from imposing firearm restrictions 2 on county, municipal, and township employees, officers, and volunteers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 7-18:

- 5 <u>A board of county commissioners may not, by any method or means, prohibit or</u> 6 <u>restrict an individual who is a county employee, officer, or volunteer, from lawfully</u> 7 <u>possessing any concealed firearm and compatible ammunition, while the individual is</u> 8 <u>within any county building, facility, or vehicle, or while on any real property, owned or</u> 9 <u>leased by the county. This section does not apply to possession of a concealed firearm</u> 10 <u>and compatible ammunition by an individual:</u> 11 (1) Who is an inmate;
- 12 (2) Who is present in a portion of a building being used to provide court or jail services;
 13 or
- 14 (3) Other than a law enforcement officer, while using a county vehicle to transport
 15 another individual apprehended in accordance with chapter 27A-10.
- 16 For purposes of this section, any "method or means" includes the adoption of a
- policy, the issuance of a guidance letter or statement, and any similar directive, whether
 written or oral.

19 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 8-4:

A board of supervisors may not, by any method or means, prohibit or restrict an individual who is a township employee, officer, or volunteer, from lawfully possessing any concealed firearm and compatible ammunition, while the individual is within any township building, facility, or vehicle, or while on any real property, owned or leased by the township. This section does not apply to possession of a concealed firearm and compatible ammunition by an individual:

9	Section 3	3. That a NEW SECTION be added to chapter 9-14:
10		The governing body of a municipality may not, by any method or means, prohibit
11	or res	trict an individual who is a municipal employee, officer, or volunteer, from lawfully
12	possessing any concealed firearm and compatible ammunition, while the individual is	
13	within any municipal building, facility, or vehicle, or while on any real property, owned or	
14	leased by the municipality. This section does not apply to possession of a concealed	
15	firearm and compatible ammunition by an individual:	
16	<u>(1)</u>	<u>Who is an inmate;</u>
17	<u>(2)</u>	Who is present in a portion of a building being used to provide court or jail services;
18		<u>or</u>
19	<u>(3)</u>	Other than a law enforcement officer, while using a municipal vehicle to transport
20		another individual apprehended in accordance with chapter 27A-10.
