Mrs. HYDE-SMITH introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To prohibit Federal funding of State firearm ownership databases, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gun Owner Registra-
5 tion Information Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING OF STATE**
7 **FIREARM OWNERSHIP DATABASES.**

8 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

9 (1) STATE.—The term “State” means each of
10 the several States, the District of Columbia, the

1 Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Commonwealth
2 of the Northern Mariana Islands, American Samoa,
3 Guam, the United States Virgin Islands, and any
4 other territory or possession of the United States.

5 (2) STATE FIREARM OWNERSHIP DATABASE.—

6 The term “State firearm ownership database”
7 means a comprehensive or partial database of a
8 State or political subdivision of a State that lists—

9 (A) firearms lawfully owned or possessed
10 by individuals; or

11 (B) individuals who lawfully own or pos-
12 sess firearms.

13 (b) PROHIBITION.—A Federal agency may not fund
14 or otherwise support the establishment or maintenance of
15 a State firearm ownership database.

16 (c) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (b) shall not apply to
17 a database of a State or political subdivision of a State
18 that lists—

19 (1) firearms that have been reported as lost or
20 stolen; or

21 (2) individuals who have reported their firearms
22 as lost or stolen.
