Mr. PERDUE introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To require Federal agencies to issue appropriate identification for the carrying of concealed firearms by qualified law enforcement officers and qualified retired law enforcement officers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Support Experienced
5 Law Enforcement Countering Terrorism Act of 2018” or
6 the “SELECT Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT FOR FEDERAL AGENCIES TO ISSUE**
2 **IDENTIFICATION.**

3 Chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, is amend-
4 ed—

5 (1) in section 926B, by adding at the end the
6 following:

7 “(g) An agency upon request by a qualified law en-
8 forcement officer who is employed by the agency, shall
9 issue identification described in subsection (d) to the
10 qualified law enforcement officer.”; and

11 (2) in section 926C, by adding at the end the
12 following:

13 “(f) An agency from which a qualified retired law en-
14 forcement officer separated shall, upon request by the
15 qualified retired law enforcement officer, issue identifica-
16 tion described in subsection (d) to the qualified retired law
17 enforcement officer.”.

18 **SEC. 3. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

19 It is the sense of Congress that State and local agen-
20 cies should issue appropriate identification to qualified law
21 enforcement officers and qualified retired law enforcement
22 officers in order for such officers to carry concealed fire-
23 arms in accordance with sections 926B and 926C of title
24 18, United States Code.
