AN ACT relating to school districts; removing the requirement that school district personnel be under contract with the school district to qualify to carry a firearm on school property; removing volunteers from the definition of employee in W.S. 21-3-132(b); and providing for an effective date.

*Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

**Section 1.** W.S. 21-3-132(b) is amended to read:

**21-3-132. Possession of firearms on school property.**

(b) For purposes of this section, "employee" means any person employed ~~under contract with the board of trustees of~~ by a school district, including but not limited to, superintendents, assistant superintendents, principals, assistant principals, teachers, guidance counselors, librarians, teacher's aids, coaches, business managers, secretaries or administrative assistants, janitors, bus drivers, ~~volunteers~~ or other employees ~~on contract with~~ of a school district.
